Paintings of jungles and rainforests are often full of wild animals surrounded by lush, exotic plants and flowers of many bright colours. These paintings often show animals in the foreground and plants and trees in the background. The weather, such as the hot sun or heavy rain and

thunderstorms, is also a common feature. Henri Rousseau is an artist who became famous for his paintings of the jungle even though he never actually saw a jungle in real life. He painted from his imagination and from books and house plants.


