Summary

Florence Nightingale was a dedicated nurse. She travelled to Crimea in the 1850s where there was a war. Many soldiers were wounded and in poor, insanitary conditions causing soldiers to die. She is significant in history because she improved the conditions for soldiers by training nurses how to prevent infections. This made nursing a profession and that is her legacy. She was known to carry an oil lamp when she checked the soldiers at night, so was called 'The Lady with the Lamp'
